Roleplay Areas:

- Nativity roleplay area

(Observations to focus upon C&L, PSED and UW. Look for children meeting 40-60 months links across these areas and evidence using 'play scripts').

Maths:

- Recognise and form numbers to 20.
- Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.
- Count actions or objects which cannot be moved.
- Count out up to six objects from a larger group.
- Selects the correct number to represent 1 to 10 objects.
- Uses the language of 'more' or 'fewer' to compare two sets of objects.
