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Living things & their habitats

- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other
- Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats
- Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food
- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways
- Explore and use classification keys to help group identify bad name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment

Recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes propose dangers to living things
