**RE: Announcement from the Prime Minister on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020**

I am writing to you following the Prime Minister's announcement on Sunday of a phased plan to beat the virus and provide a road map for re-opening society. This **may** lead to an easing of the restrictions that have been put in place to minimise the spread of COVID-19 in relation to schools.

I am sure you will have heard that if cases of COVID-19 continue to decline then children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 **may** be able to return to school from the 1<sup>st</sup> June. We currently have no further guidance on how that return might be managed.

At the moment, **there is no change to which children can come to school**, and they are children of key workers and vulnerable pupils as previously identified. For all other pupils, staff will continue to provide home learning tasks and support.

The government has said that it will release further guidance to schools on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2020 at 2pm. As soon as we are able to, we will let you know about any changes to your child's attendance in school. Please try not to contact school unless your enquiry is an urgent one.

We recognise that this is a very stressful time for children and families. Please be reassured that the safety of children, staff and parents/carers is our top priority.
