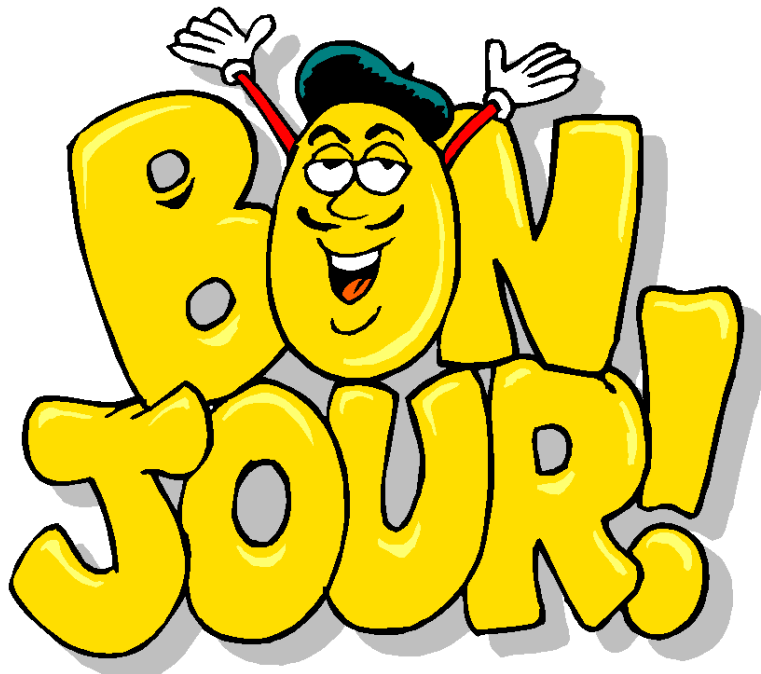

## Language Angels
